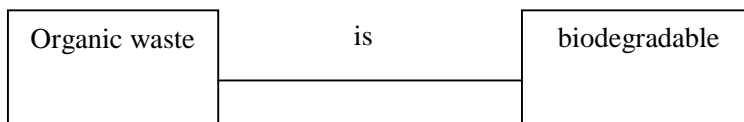


Lesson 1: Solid Waste Pre-assessment

Solid Waste Concept Map

1. Write each term below on a separate sticky note.
2. Use the dictionary or refer to: www.thinkgreen.com to look up any terms of which you are unsure.
3. Think carefully about how you want to place the terms on the poster sheet or board. You may move them around until you start to make connections.
4. Identify two related terms and draw a line between them. On that line, explain how they are related.
5. Connect as many terms together as you can. You may connect any term to as many other terms as you can manage and that make sense.
6. Use either single words, phrases, or sentences to make the connection.
7. You may use a variation of a word if it makes more sense (for example: decomposition could be used as decompose or decomposing).
8. Each valid connection receives two points. Your teacher is the final determiner about whether or not the connection is valid. Be prepared to defend your connections!
