| 5. Plastic bottles | e. More than 90% of products are shipped in these. |
| 6. Yogurt containers | f. Can be recycled into signal lights, battery cables, brushes, brooms, ice scrapers and bicycle racks. |
| 7. Glass bottles | g. On average, Americans use one of these every day but only recycle half of what we use. |
| 8. Aluminum cans | h. If you recycle 500 of these, you could save between 17 and 31 trees, 587 pounds of air pollution and 4,077 kilowatt hours of energy. |
